DIAGRAM OF HORSE - The brands and all markings must be accurately illustrated on the diagram of the horse. Any indentations, scars or hair whorls must be indicated and labelled accordingly. **HORSE MUST BE BRANDED.**

WHITE MARKINGS – shaded in, accurately defining the shape of the marking on forehead, near and off views.

BRANDS (Freeze or Fire) – a **Stock Brand** (symbol, board or one- three piece character brand) recognised by your State Authority, an **Identification Number** and a **Foaling Season Year Number**. **Branding is compulsory with the ASHS for registration purposes.**

USE BLACK PEN ONLY – THE DIAGRAM AND THE CONTENTS OF THE BOX WILL BE SCANNED ONTO THE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION.

Required for ALL registrations (except ASB Thoroughbreds) as indicated on right:

Natural Service – DNA not required, attached documents to Application for Registration as follows:
 • **ASH Breeding Certificate** – yellow or white copy (no additional fee), signed by the person who owned the stallion at time of service.
 • **Statutory Declaration or Service Certificate** (service lodgement fee applies), signed by the person who owned the stallion at time of service.
 • **Copy of Registration** with another breed Society (service lodgement fee applies), where Proof of Service was supplied when registered.

Artificial Insemination DNA (Sire Verified) or Documents required as follows:
 • Born on or after 1-8-06, DNA Verification Test is required. Submit Application for Registration with Registration and DNA fees.
 • Born before 1-8-06, attach ASH Breeding Certificate signed by Owner of Semen and Veterinarian or Qualified Person to application. For embryos, also attach an Embryo Transfer form completed and signed by the Veterinarian or Qualified person.

INSPECTION REPORT – If sire and/or dam are **not ASH Registered**, a Society Inspector appointed by the Board must inspect horses as follows: **First Cross horses** (mares and geldings) and **Special Merit horses** (mares, geldings or stallions) are eligible for inspection **at any age** after branding. **ASB Thoroughbreds** (mares and stallions) must be **at least two years old**. The options for inspection are as follows:
VIDEO INSPECTION – Standard VHS tape or DVD, procedures available on Society's Website – Horses page, click Inspections. Submit the registration with the video footage and the prescribed registration and inspection fee. **INSPECTOR IN MEMBER'S AREA** – An Inspectors' list is available on the Society's Website – Horses page, click Inspections. The horse must be inspected prior to lodging the application. Inspection fee is paid to Inspector. The Inspector must not have a pecuniary interest or conflict of interest with the owner or horse to be registered.

An inspection pass does not constitute acceptance of any application, it will be considered in accordance with the Society Regulations.

CURRENT OWNER - The current owner **must be a Financial Member** of The Australian Stock Horse Society Limited. If the sire and dam are registered Australian Stock Horses the progeny **must be registered in the dam owner's membership** and then transferred to the new owner. If the same member purchases the progeny at the same time as the dam, before the foal is one year old, no transfer fee will apply for the progeny.

Mare owner to retain the DUPLICATE ASH Breeding Certificate until the foal is born, then complete the Application for Registration and lodge, with the DUPLICATE Certificate, to the Society when eligible for registration. For Example:

- Stud Book and Second Cross – eligible at any age, once branded.
Cheapest Rates – when application lodged prior to 1st August.
- First Cross and Special Merit – eligible after attaining two years of age, branded and ready for inspection.

Embryo Transfer – Resulting progeny born on or after 1st August 2006 must be DNA Tested and Parentage Verified at time of Registration.

The mare owner is responsible for ensuring that an Embryo Transfer Form is obtained from Head Office. The Veterinarian or Qualified Person recovering and/or implanting the embryo must complete this form. The ORIGINAL ASH Breeding Certificate and Embryo Transfer Form are then lodged with the ASHS Head Office. The mare owner retains the DUPLICATE ASH Breeding Certificate together with a photocopy of the Embryo Transfer Form for Registration of the resulting foal.

LODGEMENT OF ORIGINAL ASH BREEDING CERTIFICATES TO ASHS HEAD OFFICE AS FOLLOWS:

- Mares served between August and December and no longer running with or being mated to the stallion should be submitted by 1st May of the following year.
- Mares served between August and December and still running with or being mated to the stallion in January should be submitted by 1st September of the following year.
- Mares served between January and July should be submitted by 1st September.
